Weekly Summary

This week we continued our research into the various iOS development technologies, worked to analyze the feasibility of using the Swift language for our project, met with our project advisor a second time to brainstorm project solidification questions for our client, and setup a meeting with our client for tomorrow morning to finalize our project scope and gain access to the existing code base.

Past Week Accomplishments

- Jacob: This week I setup a sandbox git repository and began developing a new iOS application from scratch to gain experience with project setup and application testing with xCode's device emulators.
- Jeffrey: Discussed questions for the client and cleared up some questions we had in general about the project. Continued work on iOS tutorials and learning. Did a bit of research on app design and good examples of applications that are good at this.

Pending Issues

- Rachel: Figuring out what are project is and what we need to be researching/learning in order to work on our project.
